Named after Harmon Heald, who founded the city of Healdsburg, this boutique hotel offers urban sophistication with a dash of country charm. Located between its sister properties of H2Hotel and Hotel Healdsburg, the Harmon features a more modern and edgy design than its siblings, with clean lines, textured concrete walls and natural materials that complement the landscape. The slatted redwood facade is visually striking, creating the impression of a posh tree house, but it also serves as a sunshade to reduce solar heat.

Earthy tones and rich textures play throughout the eco-friendly hotel, with original local artwork adorning both public and private spaces. Rooms are bright and open, with floor-to-ceiling windows, custom furniture and private balconies. Sliding partitions screen off the Fireclay Tile showers, and suites have large concrete soaking tubs. The swimming pool borders a quiet creekside park, and the rooftop bar is an ideal perch from which to catch the sunset.
